New Construction			
Energy Star Certified New Home V3	New home construction	\$2,000	Rebate for new construction of single family homes or duplexes that are 5,000 square feet or less and that obtain HERS rating of 50 or lower. Must follow Energy Star certified home national program requirements and submit inspection checklist along with HERS rating. http://www.energystar.gov/index.cfm?c=bldrs_lenders_raters.nh_v3_guidelines Modeled electrical savings excluding solar PV for which a separate incentive is being applied for must be at least 10% from county/town building code baseline.
All Insulation Rebates			Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; Blower door pre and posttest required on all insulation and air sealing projects. Must reduce air leakage by 10% (unless .45 NACH* pre blower door is met); air sealing must be performed first before insulation is installed; air sealing only projects are allowed with minimum 10% reduction; post blower door is not required on projects that meet the <=.45 NACH pre blower door. Contractor must provide pre and post blower door results. *NACH = Natural Air Changes Per Hour
Air Sealing & Weather Stripping (REQUIRED)	NACH > .45	Lesser of 30% of project cost or \$400 max	Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; Requires whole house air sealing (attic and basement/crawlspace). Must reduce air leakage by 10% unless <=.45 NACH pre blower door is met.
Air Sealing & Weather Stripping	NACH > .45	\$100	Achieve 25% or higher air leakage reduction and get \$100 bonus.
Attic Insulation	R-30 or less	Lesser of 30% of project cost or \$300 max	Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; Insulation must be installed in living spaces only; R-49 minimum required in open attic; cathedral ceilings will vary with rafter depth. Pre R-values of 40 or greater are not eligible for rebate. Air sealing is required in order to qualify for this rebate.

Measure	Existing Condition	Incentive	Rules
Floor Insulation	No Insulation	Lesser of 30% of project cost or \$300 max	Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; Insulation must be installed in living spaces only; R-30 to R-38 minimum required over unconditioned space only (i.e.: cantilevers, floors over unconditioned crawl, over garage, etc.) Fill enclosed floor cavities when R-25 is not possible. Air sealing is required in order to qualify for this rebate.
Exterior Wall Insulation	No Insulation or less than R-5	Lesser of 30% of project cost or \$700 max	Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; Air sealing required in order to qualify for this rebate. No insulation in wood-frame wall: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blow in insulation minimum R-13 into wall cavity • If re-siding, add minimum R-5 insulative sheathing before installing new siding (wall cavity must be insulated first) Insulated wood-frame wall: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If re-siding, add minimum of R-5 insulative sheathing before installing new siding
Foundation (Crawl Space or Basement) Insulation	No Insulation	Lesser of 30% of project cost or \$300 max	Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; R-15 to R-19 minimum on foundation walls. Air sealing is required in order to qualify for this rebate.
Windows & Sliding Glass Doors	Single pane, aluminum frame or windows 25 years or older	Lesser of \$2/sq ft of finished window area or \$600 max	Electric-heated (all-electric) accounts only; Replace existing windows only -- no new window openings. Windows must be new and for living spaces only. All windows and sliding glass door must have U-factor of .28 or lower. Windows and sliding glass doors must be National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) certified (www.nfrc.org). Window and door measurements must be provided. U-factor for all windows and doors must be provided to be eligible for the rebate (NFRC label comes on each window).

Ductless Heat Pump (mini-split)	Heat with electricity	\$650	Limit 2 per account; must install unit from qualifying list (find at holycross.com/rebates) and include Manual J load calculation with rebate application. New additions with electric baseboard qualify for rebate. More info at: http://energy.gov/energysaver/ductless-mini-split-heat-pumps
Evaporative Cooling (Swamp Cooler)	No previous cooling system	\$150	Standard system: 2,500 CFM; No rebate for replacing old swamp cooler with standard cooler
Evaporative Cooling (Swamp Cooler)	No previous cooling system	\$200	Premium system: 85% media saturation or above Periodic purge water control Remote thermostat control
Evaporative Cooling (Swamp Cooler)	Replace central A/C	\$175	Premium system: 85% media saturation or above Periodic purge water control Remote thermostat control
Evaporative Cooling (Swamp Cooler)	Replace central A/C or no previous cooling system	\$300	Whole House system: 85% media saturation or above Periodic purge water control Remote thermostat control Minimum of 3 supply ducts in living spaces excluding closets and bathrooms
Programmable or Wi-Fi Thermostat (Gas Heat)	Non-programmable thermostat	Lesser of 50% of project cost or \$20 max	Limit 2 per account. Participants in this program are encouraged to properly dispose of old thermostats containing mercury. Thermostats can be recycled at Charles D Jones in Glenwood or your county household hazardous waste facility.
Programmable or Wi-Fi Thermostat (Electric Heat)	Non-programmable thermostat	Lesser of 50% of project cost or \$50 max	Limit 4 per account; Participants in this program are encouraged to properly dispose of old thermostats containing mercury. Thermostats can be recycled at Charles D Jones in Glenwood or your county household hazardous waste facility.
Electric Heat Pump (Hybrid) Water Heater	Replace any type of water heater	Lesser of 30% of project cost or \$300 max	Limit 2 per account; must be Energy Star rated; https://www.energystar.gov/products/water_heaters/heat_pump_water_heaters
Recycle Working Holiday Lights	Incandescent holiday lights	\$2/string	Limit 50 strings per account per lifetime; for holiday lights that are used each season. Working incandescent holiday light strings must be turned into the Avon, Gypsum, or Glenwood Springs

Measure	Existing Condition	Incentive	Rules
Recycle Refrigerator and/or Freezer	Replace 15+ year old model	\$75	Limit 2 per account. Existing unit must be in working condition, 15 years or older , and between 10 and 30 cubic feet in capacity. Must provide picture of nameplate of refrigerator/freezer showing manufacturer, model and serial numbers to show proof of age. Evidence of proof of disposal/recycling must be furnished. LED Lighting	Replace incandescent, halogen, or T8/T12 fluorescents	Lesser of 50% of cost of LED or \$5/LED max; lifetime max of \$250	Lifetime max of \$250. Replace incandescent, halogen or T8/T12 fluorescent with LED. Rebate for lights that are used on a regular basis (more than 2 hours a day). Holy Cross recommends purchasing LEDs that meet Energy Star requirements. No rebate for replacing compact fluorescent light (CFL) with LED.
Heat Tape Timer (Hard-wired)	No timer	Lesser of 50% of project cost or \$100/timer max	Limit 2 per account. Must be permanently installed by electrician. Heat tape can use 6 to 12 watts per foot and can be a substantial source of high winter bills. Holy Cross recommends setting the timer to run heat tape from 6 am to 6 pm.
Solar Livestock Water Tank	Electric heated water tank	Lesser of 50% of solar tank or \$250 max	Limit 2 per account. Replaces electric tank heater and is used all winter long. Can be purchased on-line (http://ranchtanks.com/ or http://jugwaterers.com/jug-waterer/ are a couple of examples) or at times Roaring Fork Valley Co-op in Carbondale sells them.
