2018 grant application for large-sized businesses

GRANT INFORMATION

Holy Cross Energy (HCE) is excited to announce a \$300,000 matching grant for large businesses! This grant allows businesses in HCE territory to apply for matching funds to complete energy efficiency (electric only) projects in 2018-2019. The grant allows businesses to apply for funding above the standard estimated rebate amount for projects. This grant is

an attempt to move projects forward that have been delayed due to funding shortfalls. Businesses may also apply for rebates from other agencies such as Energy Smart Colorado and CORE.

Eligibility	 Annual revenue to HCE \$81,000 or more (combined all accounts) Grant funds maximum of 50% of qualifying project costs Business must have capital for remainder of project cost and be committed to doing the project if awarded the grant Businesses must be in good standing with HCE (no more than 2 delinquent payments in 12 months) A project can consist of either a bundle of electricity-saving measures at one or more facilities owned by the same entity or a single measure Incentives are not available for upgrades required for code compliance, including Renewable Energy Mitigation Program (REMP) in Pitkin County and Eco Build in Eagle County New construction projects are not eligible for the grant – retrofit projects only No renewable energy projects; energy efficiency upgrades only Excludes projects near completion and rebate amount has been estimated; goal of grant is to stimulate new projects
Selection Criteria (all applications will be considered regardless of the criteria - point system helps HCE choose winners fairly)	Point system will grade applications for the following: • Estimated kilowatt-hour (kWh) savings • kWh savings between 4 and 8 pm (peak load time for HCE) • No prior HCE grant has been awarded • Need for grant and how the project impacts the community • Project completion date in 2018 or early 2019 • Ability to fund remaining portion of project • Innovation – strives to promote latest technology available

Project Calculations: Provide spreadsheet of estimated kWh savings for project along with explanation on how savings were calculated. Grant is based on calculation of annual kilowatt hour savings (kWh) \times \$0.02 \times life of measure not to exceed 10 years (example: 125,000 kWh \times 0.02 \times 5.7 years = \$14,250) Example: 25,000-hour LED / 4,380 annual hours = 5.7 years life of measure
